Morning

Tour the historic village and farming museum for a taste of life 100 years ago at **Heritage Park**. Reverently walk the length of the **Veterans Wall of Honor** or stand quietly and reflect at the POW/MIA monument.

Step back in time to the final days of the Atlanta Campaign at **Nash Farm Battlefield**, the site of the largest Calvary raid in Georgia. Let a costumed tour guide take you through the action of that day and answer questions about the artifacts on display. Don't miss the new Military Museum featuring uniforms and memorabilia from World War I through present day.

Lunch

Nash Farm makes a great place for a picnic lunch and on-site catering can be arranged from a variety of local restaurants and caterers.

Afternoon

Travel just down the road to **Stately Oaks Plantation** and immerse yourself in the legend of *Gone with the Wind*. Costumed interpreters are available to give tours and share history about the house.

Dive deep into your personal history with the Genealogy Research & Archives Tour including a genealogy for beginners workshop and a tour of **National (Southeast Regional) Archives Museum**.

Dinner

After freshening up move from American history to Italian cuisine at the **Italian Oven Restaurant**. Enjoy brick oven fired pizza, classic Italian entrees and bread so good, one piece just isn't enough. Good thing there is plenty to go around!
