Hub & Spoke Tour

### Day 1

Travel 45 minutes north to Buckhead to the **Atlanta History Center**, home of the nation's largest and most comprehensive exhibition about the Civil War. Walk in the steps of a civil rights leader at **The Martin Luther King, Jr. National Historic Site** and enjoy a true southern lunch at **Pittypat's Porch** before visiting the Oval Office at the **Jimmy Carter Presidential Library & Museum**.

### Day 2

Tour the historic village at **Heritage Park** or reverently walk the length of the **Veterans Wall of Honor**. Step back in time to the final days of the Atlanta Campaign at **Nash Farm Battlefield**, the site of the largest Calvary raid in Georgia. Travel just down the road to **Stately Oaks Plantation** and immerse yourself in the legend of *Gone with the Wind*. Dive deep into your personal history with the Genealogy Research & Archives Tour including a genealogy for beginners workshop and a tour of **National (Southeast Regional) Archives Museum**.

### Day 3

Just 45 minutes south on I-75 Macon offers the option of exploring historically significant sites such as the 10,000 year-old Indian mounds at the **Ocmulgee National Monument & Indian Mounds** enjoy more modern history at the **Georgia Music Hall of Fame** and the **Georgia Sports Hall of Fame**. Macon was spared the destruction of Sherman's march, leaving many grand homes open to the public. Considered the most advanced antebellum building in America, the **Hay House**, truly is "the Palace of the South."
